

Terms and conditions: Prostate Cancer UK Oysho Royal Parks Half Marathon 2026 Team Prize Draw to win Prostate Cancer UK Merchandise Bundle

1. The promoter of this free draw is Prostate Cancer UK ("Prostate Cancer UK"), registered charity in England and Wales (1005541), and Scotland (SC039332); a company limited by guarantee registered in England and Wales (02653887). Registered office: 53 Tooley Street, London, SE1 7QN ('Prostate Cancer UK, we, us, our, Promoter').
2. This draw is open to all Prostate Cancer UK Oysho Royal Parks Half Marathon 2026 Participants. By entering Prostate Cancer UK Oysho Royal Parks Half Marathon 2026 Team Prize Draw, participants confirm that they accept the terms and conditions set out below. All entrants must be aged 18 years or over at the time of entry and legally reside within the UK (including Channel Islands and Isle of Man). Employees of Prostate Cancer UK or any of its subsidiary or affiliated companies and their immediate families and members of their households and anyone otherwise connected with operation or fulfilment of the Competition are not eligible to take part. Prostate Cancer UK reserves the right to require entrants to prove that they are eligible. If a prize winner is found to be ineligible, Prostate Cancer UK reserves the right to award the prize to the next eligible winner.
3. All entrants who have secured a charity place in the event must have completed their registration with the Oysho Royal Parks Half Marathon organisers to be eligible for entry into the draw.

The JustGiving page must be linked to both Prostate Cancer UK and the Oysho Royal Parks Half Marathon 2026 event to be eligible for entry into the prize draw. No donation, payment or purchase is necessary to enter or win this prize draw.

A free alternative method of entry is available as set out below. Entries submitted using the free alternative method of entry will be treated equally to entries generated through fundraising activity and will have an equal chance of winning.

Personal data will be processed in accordance with Prostate Cancer UK's Privacy Policy available on request.
